

The competitive reimbursement grant is available for qualified small businesses to initiate or expand export activity and grow globally. Funded in part through a partnership with the U.S. Small Business Administration. Approved companies are eligible for 75% reimbursement per activity, up to the maximum reimbursement for that activity.
