




Who Are We?




Economic Impact – Housing and Schools



Family Housing

- 2,570 units at FS and 698 units at HAAF
- 334 Apartments at Fort Stewart
- 2 / 3 / 4 bath units
- 2022 Basic Allowance for Housing Increase
 - *6.1% for Fort Stewart
 - *9.4% for Hunter Army Airfield

Federal Impact Aid Funds



Requirement: 6,070 spaces will increase to 6,375.

Available: 4,521 spaces
Enduring Problem Set through FY31

- * Approximately 29 buildings renovated
- * Estimated at \$370M cost through FY31




