

# INTERNATIONAL TRADE

## BY THE NUMBERS 2025<sup>1</sup>

Georgia's 2025 exports set records for the fifth consecutive year, propelling the state into the top 10 nationally at No. 9 and surpassing the national export growth average of 5.6% with a year-over-year gain of 12.7%. With sustained momentum, Georgia companies have increased exports over the past decade by 68.9%, demonstrating consistency, strength, and resilience in shifting environments.

Ranked No. 7 in total trade, Georgia's growth highlights its logistics leadership and global connectivity, efficiently moving products to markets across the United States and around the globe by air, rail, and sea. Seventy-nine percent of exports and 88% of bilateral trade originated in strategic markets where Georgia maintains international representation. A strategic and diverse industry base, in conjunction with a dedicated Trade team collaborating with in-market International Representatives, provides a winning combination that benefits all of Georgia.




